"BIBLIOGRAPHY"

For anyone who, for whatever unimaginable reason, may wish to delve further into my drab history, there is rather too much material stored in a number of albums, folders, scrapbooks and pouches which will augment, chiefly pictorially, this record of my life and the people and experiences which have affected it. This voluminous reference collection includes:-

- 1 "Family"- a photo album covering my grandparents through to my grandchildren, plus aunts, uncles, cousins and in-laws (and a number of unknowns!).
2. Six, or more, ring binders of photos covering our life in and around Senneville, holiday trips in Canada, Europe and elsewhere, and more "People".
3. A photo album (multi-colour plastic weave) compiled by Hazel concerned chiefly with the early years of Tim and Brian, but including also miscellaneous other people and events, and with record photos of 232.
