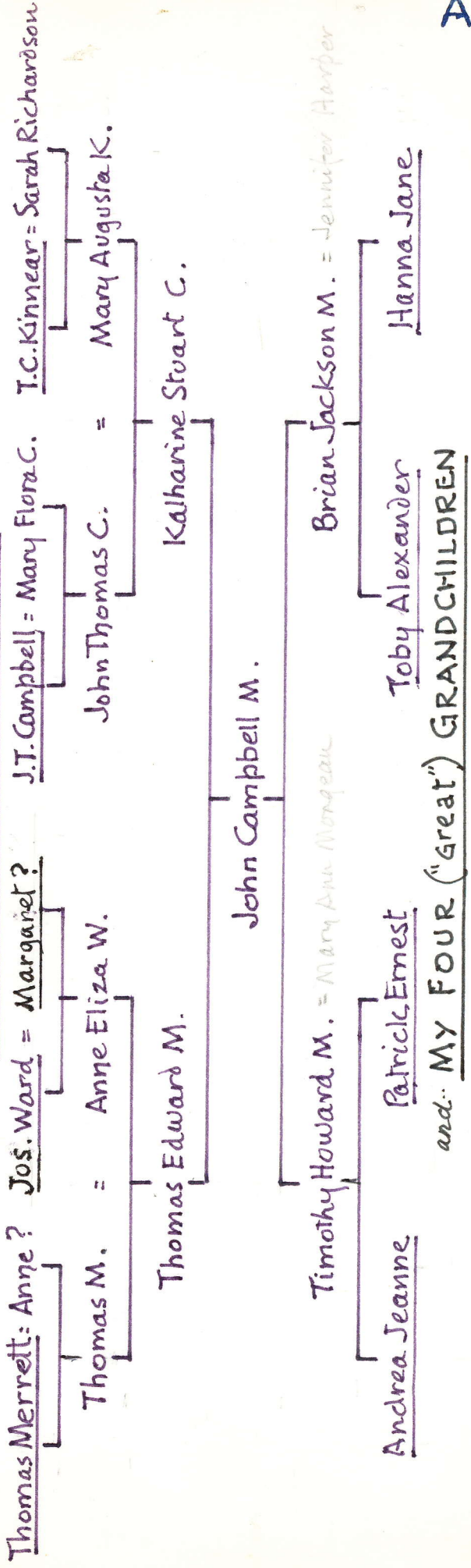

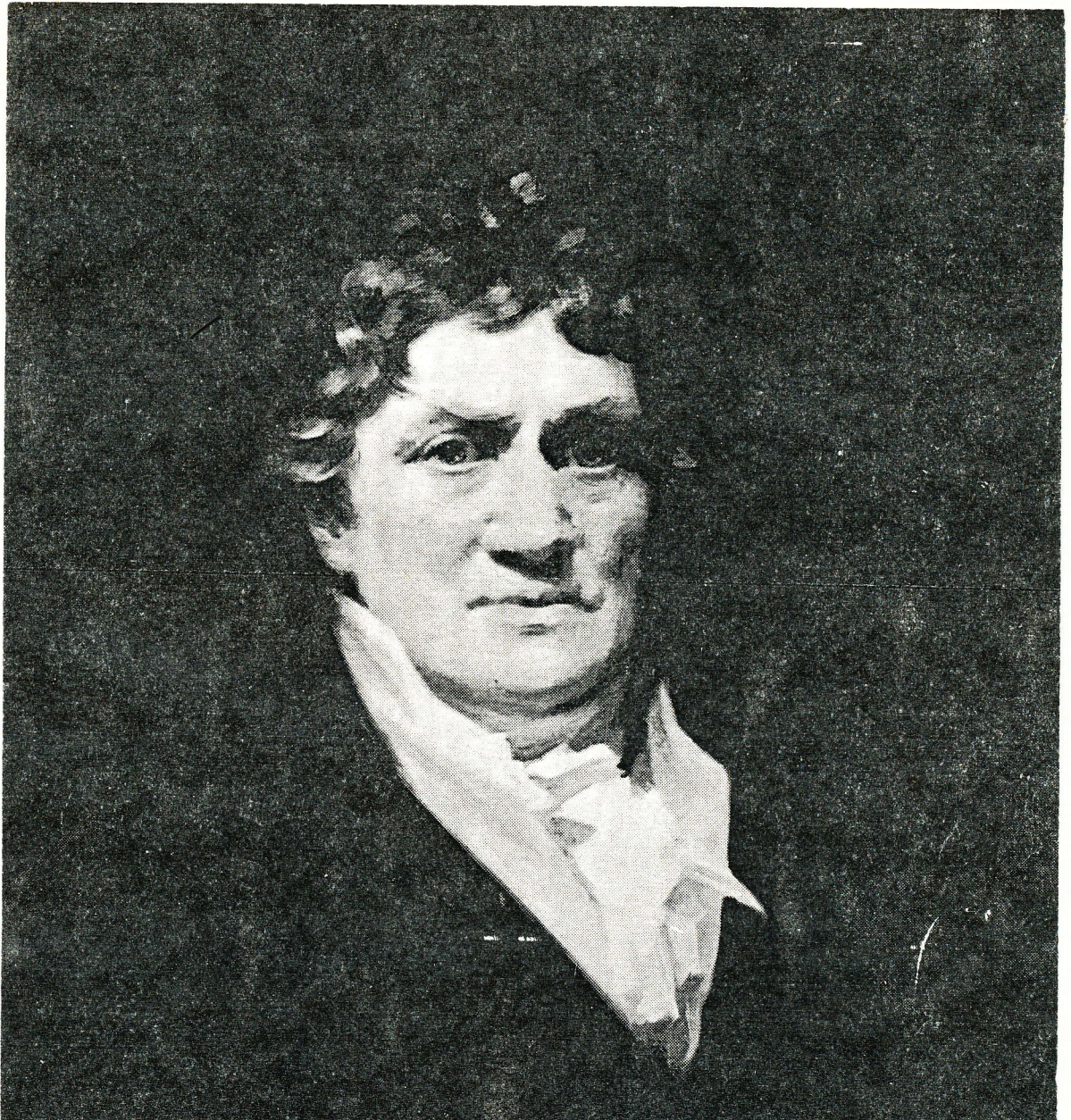

The Campbell portraits in the Glasgow Art Gallery are of: John Campbell of Morriston (3rd son of Capt. Alexander Campbell and Helen Campbell of Glenlyon) 1735 - 1808, of his wife Marion Murdoch 1750 - 1812, of Capt. Alexander Campbell c.1700 - c.1770, and of his wife Helen Campbell of Glenlyon---I haven't the date but the note: "the granddaughter of Capt. Robert Campbell of Glenlyon and Glencoe!!!" The portraits were given by the last descendant of Mungo Campbell of Hundleshope, who was an elder brother of J.C. of M. Apparently she bequeathed a number of family portraits to the gallery; so if Tim goes there he may find more; and he should be able to get photo-copies; I have the four which Archie Taylor had. PERSONAL NOTES on some Campbells.
(received from David Marriott).

ALEXANDER was the third son of Colin Campbell, Wadsetter of Dalkillin in Glen Quaich. Colin Campbell is described in the records as "in Acharne" which may mean that he leased rather than owned that property.

He evidently left Dalkillin quite young and lived for a time at Doune. He certainly served in the Army and was a Captain, probably in the Earl of Argyll's regiment of Foot. He fought for the Government in the '45 and was rewarded with a Collectorship of Customs at Greenock. There he possibly indulged in private sugar-trading with the West Indies since his three sons entered this trade very profitably to themselves. His birth and death dates are approximately 1700 and 1770.

JOHN (of Morriston) was the third son of the above Alexander. He was born 1735 and died 1808. He founded the Glasgow firm of John Campbell, senior, sugar-brokers. This business lasted till it was wound up in 1866. He was evidently very rich. He bought Morriston in 1796 and sold it in 1808.

JOHN THOMAS was the fourth son of the above John of Morriston and was a partner in his firm. He was born in 1790 and died in 1866. He is buried in the Dean cemetery at Edinburgh (Plot No. 83). He does not seem ever to have bought himself a property and was certainly never a Campbell of Camiseskan like his brother Colin though there is evidence of his being so described in certain Scots family records.

JOHN THOMAS who was born 1834 and died 1897, was the eldest son of the above John Thomas. In 1851 he entered the Army as Ensign in the 72nd Duke of Albany's Highlanders (1st Seaforth's). He served throughout the Crimean War, where he was wounded and transferred in 1857 as a Captain to the 7th Royal Fusiliers. He was married in Halifax N.S. in 1860. In 1862 he transferred to the Royal Canadian Rifle Regt. in Canada. He retired as a Major (hon. Lieut. Colonel) in 1868 on the disbandment

of the R.C.R. Regt. of which he was due to take command. He returned to Scotland and lived at Strachur, Argyllshire. There his wife Mary Augusta died. He then married Barbara Natalie Macleay and settled in Co. Mayo with her and his five daughters. Later he returned to Canada and settled in Kingston, Ontario. His wife returned to Scotland and died there in 1910. Eventually he returned to Edinburgh with his youngest daughter Violet, the rest having married. He is buried with his father, his mother, and his two wives in the Dean's Cemetery, Edinburgh. One vacant space remained in this family tomb and it was filled by his eldest daughter, Alice Madeleine Taylor who died in 1937. Her children paid a compounded fee to the cemetery for perpetual maintenance.

**Former Banker
Dies in N.S.**

**Frederick Merrett, 72,
Was Noted Athlete
In Youth** 1941

KENTVILLE, N.S., March 3—(C.P.) — Frederick Merrett, 72, retired banker, said by friends to have been a member of an Ottawa Stanley cup team in the early years of the century, died at his home here yesterday following a brief illness.

After 45 years on the staff of the Bank of Montreal in various parts of Eastern Canada, Mr. Merrett retired while the manager of the bank at nearby Wolfville a decade ago.

Friends said he played on three Ottawa hockey teams for several seasons—Bankers, Ottawa Rideaus and the famous Silver Seven, thrice Stanley Cup champions.

He played football for Ottawa and was a member of one of the Dominion's first trap shooting teams. Mr. Merrett was one of the first in Canada to take up skiing.

He was born at the military barracks, St. John's, Que., where his father, the late Captain Thomas Merrett was stationed. Later Capt. Merrett was attached to the Royal Military College, Kingston, Ont., and Mr. Merrett spent his early childhood there.

His banking career included managementships of banks in Schreiber, Ont.; Cornwall, Ont.; Ottawa, Sawyerville, Que., and Wolfville.

Surviving are his widow, one son, Frederick, at home, and a daughter, Mrs. J. P. Knowlton, Kentville. A brother, Thomas E. Merrett, retired manager of the St. James St. Branch of the Bank of Montreal, Montreal, and a sister, Mrs. Benson, wife of General Benson, retired, of Victoria.
