

[I quote from The Columbia Desk Encyclopedia (1953) and from The Encyclopedia of "HOWARD, British noble family. First called HEREWARD, their career in England 10th century. A Hereward fought against William I. His descendants were of Arundel (1139), Barons Malmesbury (1330), Earls of Surrey and Dukes Barons Fitzalan (1627), Earls of Norfolk (1644) and Barons Hertford (1884) of Suffolk, Carlisle and Effingham, and the Lord Howard of Glossop represent its younger lines." Catherine Howard was a niece of Thomas Howard, Norfolk and the 5th wife of Henry VIII, and Lord Howard of Effingham of Queen Elizabeth's fleet which defeated the Spanish Armada in 1588. Tradition says that our family can be traced back to the Earl of Effingham, descendant of Lord Howard of Effingham. This is upheld by the fact that some of us are accustomed to associate with our branch of the family having Effingham lion. My father, E. Edwin Howard, points this out in notes which say, in part: "The lion forms part of the different Howard crests nor always given the same posture or shape. For example, on the crest of Norfolk, who is the head of the family, the tail of the lion is curved. That of the Earl of Carlisle is the lion rampant, I believe, and so is that of de Walden. That of the Earl of Effingham has the tail extended. The motto 'Virtus mille Scutis' means 'Virtue (in the sense of 'manhood' or 'Valour') is the shield'. The other branches of the family have mottoes that are very much the same idea." The lion which we think as "ours" has its tail extended.

The present (1986) head of the family is Bernard Shanduke Fitzalan 16th Duke of Norfolk, premier duke of the Kingdom and earl marshal. He lives in Arundel Castle, Sussex.

"Seeking their religious freedom a branch of the Howard family went to the United States - etc. finally coming to the New World where they became one branch, wishing to remain under British rule, moved with their slaves to Rhode Island but soon moved to Mass. In Fitchburg their family history emblazoned with the crest and motto 'Virtus mille Scutis'.
